

ARTIST AND EXHIBITION GUIDELINES

CURVE FOYER GALLERY

Throughout the year, we are pleased to offer visual artists in the region with the opportunity to display their work to our many thousands of visitors a year in our Foyer Gallery.

Over the past year, we have presented two major exhibitions by graduating Fine Art students from De Montfort University, alongside exhibitions by Emma Jackson, Paul Barrant and Lynne Howarth.

If you are interested in displaying your work at Curve, please note as follows:

- Work is only presented by formally trained artists.
- All artwork is displayed at the artist's own risk, and we advise artists to have their own insurance in place. Work is displayed in Curve's public spaces without full-time invigilation and Curve accept no liability for any damage or theft.
- All artwork must be suitable for installation through our fixed steel-cable hanging system. All artwork will require appropriate mirror-plates attached in order to be installed.
- All artwork must be approved before installation. Work must be suitable for our diverse, family audience.
- Curation and installation will be carried out by the artist, supported by members of the Curve Facilities Team. Installation must take place between 10am and 6pm, Monday to Friday.
- Artists must provide appropriate signage for exhibitions, on Curve-branded templates. Where Curve undertake provision of any signage, such costs will be charged back to the artist.
- Exhibitions are usually installed for six to eight weeks.
- Curve do not charge any hire fee for use of the gallery facility.
- Curve will promote exhibitions online, through social media and in any appropriate print.
- Work is not offered for sale at Curve, and Curve staff will refer any sales enquiries directly to the artist.
